As in 2023, payments are to be done only by e-transfer. If you have difficulty doing this, ask a friend you trust to assist. It is a safe and effective way to transfer funds which eliminates much manual labour for the Treasurer and allows faster application processing time for the Membership Director.

Please note that new members are being encourage to try the sport of tennis. This season, new members only, can play for only \$395. We think it is important to offer this discount in order to encourage new players to "give it a try".

Returning QPTC members will be able to utilize their existing CourtReserve account to register for the 2024 Season. When completing the online application, you may either agree to give a minimum 2 hours of your time to assist where needed and when requested, or opt out of volunteering and be charged an additional \$50 above your membership fee. Please also note that free memberships for "Family" juniors have been changed. They are very welcome to be active at the club but a \$50 fee has been established. Those who only visit occasionally may be better treated as "guests".

New Members Are Welcome to the 2024 Registration System. We are excited you want to be part of the Quaker Park Tennis Club this year. Please read this entire set of instructions prior to completing the forms to avoid delays. You should have checked out our different memberships and selected the one that applies to you. (See the chart above, Andrew's email, or the website.)

Processing Your Membership:

There are 3 steps in processing your membership (After you click 'Create Account' button at the end of the form)

Step 1 - We receive notice of your application.

<u>Step 2</u> – You will receive an email welcoming you to the club and providing you with some basic information regarding the rules of the club. At this point, your membership is INACTIVE. The email will also detail how to make your payment to the club in order to activate your membership.

<u>Step 3</u> - This is when you need to make the payment to the club. This payment should be made via **e-transfer to membership@qptc.ca** within 48 hours of your application.

Once the funds are received, your account will be activated, and you will be able to book courts and access the member portal. An envelope with your name on it, containing a shoe tag and the new password to access the member portal will be waiting for you in the club house once you are activated.

If funds are not received within the 48-hour time frame, your application will be withdrawn and you will need to start the process again.

Applying for Student and Junior Memberships – Please note additional information is required when applying for either of these two categories. Not providing this information will result in delays in processing the membership.

- Student Memberships This membership requires that you enter your age and the school you are registered in.
- Junior Memberships This membership requires you to insert the date of birth of the junior as well as the school he/she is registered in and the full name of the parent.

Adult Membership - V (volunteering) vs Adult Membership-NV (non-volunteering)

Volunteering time is essential to the operation of our club. If you do not wish to or are unable to volunteer a minimum of 2 hours to the club, choose Adult Membership – NV. Note that there is an additional cost to not volunteering during the season. If you have not been approached to help out, it is your responsibility to contact a member of the Executive before the end of the season to fulfill your commitment or pay the additional \$50. Keep an eye on your email for the confirmation email that your membership has been accepted to proceed to the payment phase as soon as possible.
